




• **ELABORATION:** The grapes enter the chamber until the temperature drops to 2-4°. Alcoholic fermentation for 20 days and ageing for 10-12 months in old French oak barrels.

- COLOR: Clean, bright cherry red.
- AROMA:: Intense aromas of ripe blueberries and currants give way to balsamic notes of Mediterranean undergrowth, like licorice, rosemary, and thyme, providing freshness. The experience is like walking into the forest on a spring day.
- TASTE: It is clean and direct, mimicking the environment of the vineyard—blackberries, plums, and cherries—blended with an intense mix of licorice, pink pepper, delicate tannins, and salty touches that lead you, little by little, toward the sunset.
