Grenache is the variety of a thousand and one faces; we have bottled for you the fine face, the subtle and delicate face of the Peluda Grenache. The rosé of Media will transport you to a vineyard of height and calcareous clay soil. An idyllic corner of the Serra de Llaberia where you will enjoy the sunsets and the Mediterranean breezes in every glass. Perfect company to enjoy midnight.

- **SOIL TYPE:** Calcareous clay with a very stony and shallow surface, poor in organic matter.
- **VITICULTURE:** Ecologically certified by C.C.P.A.E. and in Conversion.
- **VARIETY:** 100% Grenache: hairy, grafted from a selection of the best vines of Viña del Teixar.
- **VINTAGE:** Harvest Classification: Excellent. A spring abundant in rains and a dry summer has made the vegetative growth of the plant balanced, not suffering the hydric stress of recent years. The harvest began on 25th September.
- **ELABORATION:** The grapes enter the chamber until the temperature drops to 2-4°. Skidded and bled to begin alcoholic fermentation, wild yeasts and five months with fine lees.
- **COLOR:** Clean and bright, very soft grapefruit reddish tones.
- **AROMA:** Its complexity and finesse reminds you of a bouquet of white and pink flowers accompanied by a melody of red and yellow fruits. In the background there are some delicious notes of liquorice and aromatic herbs of rosa canina and wild strawberry, finishing with some intense saline notes.
- **TASTE:** Surprisingly smooth, it is velvety and deep, reminiscent of the structure of the hairy. Grenache. Its wild raspberry red fruit plays with the fruity notes and white flower, pear, canine rose and a range of balsamic notes and saline touches that merge, no doubt, into a long-lasting and gastronomic Rosé so that you never feel alone at midnight. As time goes by, the Rosado de Media reveals its most delicate secrets to us to be shared any day in any place, while boarding Tren de mitjanit. (Midnight Train.)
